

**Engine starting**

Check engine and gearbox oil to ensure levels are correct – See manual if further information is required

- Set the engine throttle to at least 1/3, out of gear.
- Turn the Key to the “1” position.

The panel will go through a procedure, to ensure all lights and the buzzer are working, once this has been completed you can then start the engine. First Start of the day, from cold or initial installation

- Turn the Key to the Pre-Heat position and hold until the yellow light goes out
- Turn the Key to the Start/Crank position and release when the engine fires.

Ensure alarm buzzer is not sounding and red warning lights are off. If the alternator warning light is still on then increase the engine speed to excite the alternator, then return to idle. The light should then go out. Also make sure the engine is running smoothly, with no smoke and sounds normal.

**Stopping**

Every propulsion engine is fitted with a stop solenoid. To stop the engine simply turn the key to the “0” position and the engine will stop.

**First Service**

Your new marine engine will require an engine service and check over **at 50 hours**, the LCD display within the tachometer shows the engine running hours.

It is very important this is carried out, as this goes through many checks to ensure the engine has settled down. ***This is chargeable and is your responsibility to organise, failure to do so may invalidate your warranty.***

**Genuine Parts**
